

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

SOUTH HAMS DISTRICT COUNCIL

AMENDMENT No. 3 TO OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2015

NOTICE is hereby given that SOUTH HAMS DISTRICT COUNCIL proposes to make an Amendment Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to implement an Amendment Order containing provisions as set out in the schedule to the order.

- (a) To continue with current arrangements and re-advertise in respect of tax-exempt disabled motorists, which allows motorists an additional hour of parking time upon the expiry time of a P&D ticket if displayed with a valid blue badge.
- (b) To allow free parking at the Dartmouth Park & Ride site during the closed season, when the park and ride service is not in operation.
- (c) To limit the parking permitted to permit holders on the South Embankment in Dartmouth to a maximum of four hours per day.
- (d) To permit loading only on the North Embankment in Dartmouth.
- (e) To permit parking only with the express permission of South Hams District Council on the Rotherfold in Totnes.
- (f) Full and Commuter Permits to be eliminated and replaced with Town Centre, Peripheral and Rural Permits which will be limited to specific towns/ villages. The cost of permits to be reduced to reflect the new restrictions, with the exception of Business Permits.
- (g) All permits to become paperless, with the exception of Business Permits, and will be 'virtual' permits.
- (h) New permits to be limited to one vehicle registration number only, with the exception of Business Permits.

- (i) The availability of permits to be limited to 10% of the total number of parking bays available for each category of permit.
- (j) Permits currently issued free of charge to various organisations to be ceased.
- (k) Other permits to be eliminated. These include:
 - Creek reserved, Salcombe
 - Aveton Gifford boat
 - Disabled annual permits
- (l) The Residents' Parking Permit to be extended to allow parking from 3pm to 10am, with an increase in cost to £40.00.
- (m) The cost of all other permits to be amended.

If any person wishes to object or make representation in respect of the making of the Amendment Order they must do so in writing submitted to Ms C Aubertin, Operations Manager (Environment Services), South Hams District Council, Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, TQ9 5NE, or by email to Cathy.Aubertin@swdevon.gov.uk. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.

Any objections or representations must be submitted during the 21 day consultation period, which will close on Friday 3rd February 2017.
